<p><b><u>1</u></b> <b>Crushing:</b></p> <p>Tell me what could happen to cause a crushing injury.</p>	<p><b><u>2</u></b> <b>Seatbelts:</b></p> <p>Tell me when and why we wear seatbelts?</p>	<p><b><u>3</u></b> <b>Intersections:</b></p> <p>Tell me how you must enter an intersection and name two (2) ways to reduce risks?</p>	<p><b><u>4</u></b> <b>Overhead Door Hazards:</b></p> <p>Demonstrate or ask for two (2) hazards using overhead doors.</p>	<p><b><u>5</u></b> <b>Cuts on Job:</b></p> <p>Ask associates how cuts can occur in their jobs such as knives, slip sheets, nails etc.</p>	<p><b><u>6</u></b> <b>Trips / Falls:</b></p> <p>Give me three (3) ways to prevent trip/slip/fall hazards?</p>	<p><b><u>7</u></b> <b>Running Lines - Body Parts:</b></p> <p>Keep within running lines of equip. Discuss how it could cause a foot injury.</p>
<p><b><u>8</u></b> <b>Evacuations:</b></p> <p>Talk about meeting areas, getting off equip and walking to the evacuation areas.</p>	<p><b><u>9</u></b> <b>Parking Lots / Crosswalks:</b></p> <p>Discuss the location of cross walks and ways reduce risk in the yard. - <b>NO PHONES!</b></p>	<p><b><u>10</u></b> <b>Dock / Overhead Door Safety:</b></p> <p>Give me three (3) ways to be injured when working with or around overhead doors?</p>	<p><b><u>11</u></b> <b>Seatbelts:</b></p> <p>Give two (2) reasons why you must wear a seatbelt when sitting on equipment?</p>	<p><b><u>12</u></b> <b>Running Lines:</b></p> <p>Have an employee show running lines on a piece of equipment.</p>	<p><b><u>13</u></b> <b>Foot Injuries:</b></p> <p>What task today could contribute to a foot injury and what must be done to reduce risks?</p>	<p><b><u>14</u></b> <b>Data Plate:</b></p> <p>Bring a piece of equipment to the meeting and discuss-what is the data plate</p>
<p><b><u>15</u></b> <b>Pinch Points:</b></p> <p>Ask for areas in the facility where pinch points exist. Talk about ways to reduce risk of injury.</p>	<p><b><u>16</u></b> <b>Demonstrate Proper Lifting:</b></p> <p>Can someone demonstrate the proper way to lift overhead? <b>-Keep Elbows In!!</b></p>	<p><b><u>17</u></b> <b>Intersections:</b></p> <p>Tell me how you must enter an intersection and name two (2) ways to reduce risks?</p>	<p><b><u>18</u></b> <b>Dismounting:</b></p> <p>Show me three (3) points of contact – tell me why you use it?</p>	<p><b><u>19</u></b> <b>Use Quiz</b></p>	<p><b><u>20</u></b> <b>Pinch Points:</b></p> <p>Bring a piece of powered equipment and demonstrate powered equip and racking pinch points backing into a rack.</p>	<p><b><u>21</u></b> <b>Intersections:</b></p> <p>Tell me three (3) ways to communicate at an intersection?</p>
<p><b><u>22</u></b> <b>Trailer Damage:</b></p> <p>Talk about damage to the inside of trailers while loading and hazards inside.</p>	<p><b><u>23</u></b> <b>Expect the Unexpected:</b></p> <p>When walking a facility what are two (2) overhead hazards you may see?</p>	<p><b><u>24</u></b> <b>Body Parts:</b></p> <p>Tell/show me the running lines of your equipment?</p>	<p><b><u>25</u></b> <b>Merry Christmas!!!</b></p>	<p><b><u>26</u></b> <b>Lifting:</b></p> <p>When lifting overhead objects can someone show me how your elbows need to be?
